Access to treatment services for individuals and families impacted by gambling is a priority of the Missouri Department of Mental Health-Division of Behavioral Health. The Department contracts with certified gambling disorder counselors across the state to provide treatment services.

No cost treatment is possible as a portion of casino admission fees is allotted to the state. To receive services, individuals must be 18 years of age, be a resident of the state of Missouri, and meet admission criteria.

Services available to those impacted by gambling include individual counseling, group counseling and family therapy. Family members affected by a problem gambler can also receive treatment services.
